Although still new to the staff of the Alabama Wildlife Center, I have come to appreciate that this is a dynamic organization with dedicated staff and volunteers who are passionate about fulfilling AWC's mission. Volunteers are the backbone and strength of our organization helping out in so many ways, working together to fulfill our mission. Some of the duties that they performed this past year include transporting injured raptors, releasing rehabilitated birds, feeding orphaned baby birds, cleaning aviaries, doing laundry, performing administrative duties, repairing aviaries, tending to maintenance of our laundry equipment, building and grounds, greeting visitors, assisting with fund raising events and educational programs, answering calls on our Help Line, and so many other daily tasks. And we certainly could not do without the generosity of several local veterinarians and their staff who donate their time and expertise in evaluating and treating our injured birds when needed. We are truly thankful for the support and assistance received from each and every volunteer.

This past October we hired Lynn Brown as Rehabilitation Director. Lynn is an experienced rehabilitator and birder and she hit the ground running as she began a thorough evaluation of our overall clinic procedures and protocols, and initiated some badly needed repair work on our outdoor aviaries.

Our educational programs and outreach are an integral part of our overall mission. In 2011 Education Director Sandra Allinson significantly expanded our educational programming and outreach and added a fourth gloved-trained raptor to our ed bird team. The American Kestrel, named Legacy, came to us as a juvenile with foot injuries which prevented his return to the wild. He is an audience favorite because of his small size, beautiful coloring and perky disposition.

As many nonprofit organizations struggle during these difficult economic times, we are acutely aware that the funding we receive from our donors – members, individuals, corporations and foundations – must be used with the utmost of care. We will continue to seek efficiencies in our operations while enhancing our services and programs.

On April 28, the impact of the violent storms and tornadoes that destroyed so much of our beautiful state was seen and felt by thousands. Painfully evident was the enormity of the devastation with human lives lost, beloved pets injured or missing and homes destroyed. Not so obvious to many was the impact the storms had on Alabama's native wild birds. At AWC, however, we felt the immediate result with a dramatic increase in patients, especially for birds that utilize trees as nesting sites.

The day after the storms, a call from the Chilton County Humane Society came in on our Help Line. Some "very large" baby woodpeckers had been discovered in a downed tree as the transportation department was cleaning up some of the storm's aftermath. The scared and hungry cries of the babies could be heard in the background and we knew two Pileated Woodpeckers would be arriving at AWC in need of help. Later the same day, yet another Pileated was found in Oak Mountain State Park after losing his home in the storm. These three babies were almost juveniles, and had spent enough time growing up in the wild to know they did not belong at AWC under the care of humans. Two weeks of difficult force-feedings put our staff and experienced volunteers to the test but ensured the babies got the nutrition they needed to develop normally. Finally they began to willingly accept hand-feedings and soon enough they began to eat on their own, bringing forth a new challenge of keeping enough food available for these over-sized juveniles! Set up in an aviary that had been modified to both afford the birds' privacy and to accommodate their vertical perching, the woodpeckers thrived under our care. They were released on June 15th and began their free, wild lives in the woods behind AWC. We can still hear their calls from time to time, so we know they are doing well out there!




AWC By the Numbers

Write a Little Note From Stone Forest

On Aug 28, the impact of the violent storms and tornadoes that destroyed so much of our beautiful state was seen and felt by many. The Alabama Wildlife Center was no exception, with numerous lost, injured and missing birds. While we were unable to find or rescue many of the birds that had been lost, we did find many more that had been found, especially those who utilize trees as nesting sites.

On Aug 29, the impact of the violent storms and tornadoes that destroyed so much of our beautiful state was seen and felt by many. The Alabama Wildlife Center was no exception, with numerous lost, injured and missing birds. While we were unable to find or rescue many of the birds that had been lost, we did find many more that had been found, especially those who utilize trees as nesting sites.

A call from a young man in Guntersville informed us that he had found a pair of nestling raptors in his front yard. He had found them while mowing and the best he could with no power and limited means for over 100 miles to the nearest town. We were able to transport the babies, and once they arrived at AWC, it was clear that only one was still alive. The other had died. We were able to care for the live baby, and once it was strong enough, we released it back into the wild. As the baby faced with growing up alone, we were also very concerned about

Generous Gift Serves Dual Purpose

A generous gift from the estate of Dr. John H. Estep and Mrs. Grace McMillan Estep provided an opportunity to install video cameras in our Raptor Wing aviaries. The monitors are set up in one of our public rooms in the main building so that both staff and the public can view our patients. This system serves a dual purpose: (1) it is a tool for our clinic staff to monitor the rehabilitation process of raptors and water birds without human contact, and (2) it provides the public a view of the birds during the rehabilitation process. It is important to minimize human contact with raptors so as to minimize stress on the birds and avoid imprinting of juvenile raptors. The cameras offer staff an opportunity to monitor their condition throughout the day and provide visitors a behind the scenes look at our patients.

Bringing People Together

AWC participated in a Colorado State University research project comparing blood samples of Barred Owls with those of Spotted Owls. The project was looking for the presence of 3 to 4 blood parasites in Barred Owls that are commonly found in Spotted Owls.

A second opportunity to collaborate with a university involved the Auburn University Southeastern Raptor Center (SERC). Auburn is well known and respected for its raptor rehabilitation and education programs. Their rehabilitation staff was interested in learning about our songbird program and visited AWC for a day of professional development. SERC in turn invited AWC staff to spend a day learning about their raptor education and rehabilitation programs. The exchange presented an excellent professional development opportunity for the staff of both programs and we expect that this will become a regular yearly exchange.

One of our signature educational programs now in its 21st year, is Audubon Teaches Nature (ATN). The Birmingham Audubon Society, Alabama Wildlife Center, Oak Mountain Interpretive Center and Friends of Oak Mountain partner to provide seminars that will enhance the knowledge and skills of individuals interested in Alabama's natural history. ATN provides a unique opportunity to meet and learn from Alabama's leading naturalists. Included in the 2011 lineup was Dr. Doug Phillips, host of the Emmy award-winning Alabama Public Television series, "Discovering Alabama."

2011 signaled the 25th year of the AWC collaboration with the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources and Oak Mountain State Park. Although AWC receives no direct state or federal funding, DCNR provides a facility and land within Oak Mountain State Park to house the AWC rehabilitation program.

Developing Leaders

Late in 2011 AWC officially established a junior board of directors to help promote awareness of AWC and assist with fundraising activities. This group of dynamic young professionals calls itself Raptor Force and is promoting AWC through various means including hosting receptions, assisting with educational programs and events, and use of social media. The group meets monthly to network and review business and they sit in on Board meetings on an ad hoc basis. Raptor Force is planning their first major fund raising event for the late summer of 2012 which they anticipate will become their annual signature fund raising event.
